 - Covers Central Indiana

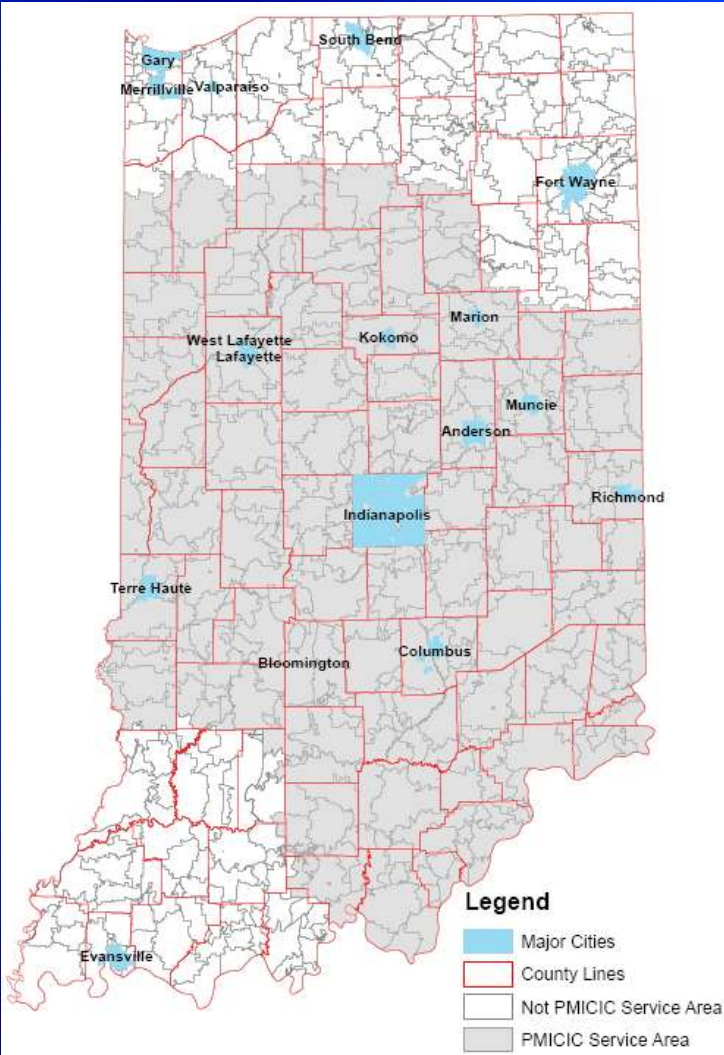
Region 2 Service Area
